May:

Children OR Pets, OR Child AND Pet. (MORE than ONE).

ie: a group of children, or a group of animals, or a child with pet or pets.

June:

Weddings- BRIDE. (A bride only, no groom or anyone else).

ie: A formal or candid portrait of a BRIDE only. NO other people in photo.

October:

Senior: This can be a High School Senior OR an OLD Person.

ie: Formal OR Candid photo of either ONE young OR old person, (60 or older). Any setting.

November:

Families: This can be any traditional family portrait.

This category is the same as always. Candid or Formal.

January:

Pre-State Competition - Out of Area Judges.

This is our traditional "Open" competition with 4 entries allowed. Portrait, Illustrative, Wedding OR Commercial categories.

February:

Pre-State Competition - Local IPPA Judges.

This is our second and final Pre-State Competition before State Convention. 4 Entries allowed, same as January. But local judges.
